- R1 **Pinot Grigio** Jermann "Sylvios Vendage" 2007 *Friuli* 58.
Another example of Sylvio's ability to create a wine in which richness combines with suppleness and structure. A faint coppery glow giving way to ripe melon and fruit
- R2 **Bugia (Ansonica)** by Bibi Greatz 2006, *Island of Giglio, Tuscany* 110.
This unusual white wine is made from 100% Ansonica grapes and is intensely aromatic with notes of honey, vanilla, melon, and a touch of eucalyptus. It is highly flavorful, fruity and rich with a pleasantly clean finish, featuring a touch of oak
- R3 **Chardonnay** Elena Walch "Beyond the Clouds" 2007 *Alto Adige* 95.
Bright, deep yellow, A complex interplay of floral and fruit aromas. The fruit aromas follow through on to the palate, supported by richness, concentration, firm but mild acidity with a hint of vanilla. An exciting wine which bodes well for the future.
- R4 **Barbera D' Alba** Lodali Lorens 2005 *Piemonte* 98.
This rich and full bodied barbera is named for the winemakers Father and estate owner Walter Lodali. Only 4 barrels of wine are produced and it spends 20 months in barrique and another 12 months in bottle before release.
- R5 **Pinot Nero** Alois Lageder "Krafus" 2005 *Alto Adige* 83.
Medium intense ruby colour with a garnet shimmer, clean uplifted varietal aroma: impressions of red berry fruit, cherries along with oak spice (white pepper, cinnamon)
- R6 **Desiderio** Avignonese 2005 *Tuscany* 88.
85 Percent Merlot, 15 Percent Cabernet 100 Percent new French wood.
Exotically rich deep and powerful.
- R7 **Cepparello** Isola e Olena 2005 *Tuscany* 115.
The best 10 percent of Paolo de Marche's sangiovese grapes are selected for a long fermentation and aging in French wood. Perfectly balanced and powerful.
- R8 **Stignano** San Vincenti 2004 *Tuscany* 75.
this wine manages to have a really remarkable density and develops on the palate with evident fruity reserves.

Bordeaux-style blend 50% Cab, 40% Merlot 10% Petit Verdot, rich and powerful
- R15 **Sforzato "Ronco del Picchio"** Sandro Fay 2005 *Lombardy* 98.
100% Nebbiolo that are dried for 2 months (similar to Amarone which give it a richer, fuller body) with lots of dark berry fruit flavors, and firm tannins.
- R16 **Cabernet Sauvignon** Isole e Olena 2003 *Tuscany* 85.
Elegant yet powerful Bordeaux style handpicked, destemmed and macerated for 30 days, Then aged in 50% new Allier barrels. without filtration or fining.

The generous nose releases aromas of fragrant wild berries that meld with coco powder,
